Flashover Recognition – Hands On Checklist

(For Hosting Agency)

Metal Container for after burn debris A Dumpster or 4 large metal trash cans are needed to put hot debris inside of after burn evolutions, and then sprayed with water for additional safety measures. This will be upon the Hosting Agency (Fire Department) to dispose of according to their jurisdictional guidelines for burnt Class A fuels/waste.

Minimum of (2) Pumper Firetrucks (1250 GPM Minimum) to be dedicated to & utilized for the training.

2000 Gallon of Water in reserve (Dump Tank or Tanker) to be dedicated and utilized for the training.

<u>Live Fire Competency Forms</u> completed for each Firefighter/Student participating in the training.

Form of Identification (an official form) to verify identity and age

Structural PPE within 10 years of manufacture date; NFPA 1851.

Compliance with OSHA 1910.134 (No Facial Hair impeding facepiece sealing surface)

Minimum of 10 Students PARTICIPATING in Hands On portion of training.

No Camera or Recording Device inside of the Operational Zone for Live Fire Training. The Operational Zone shall be set forth by the Lead Instructor and enforced by any Instructor and/or attendee.
